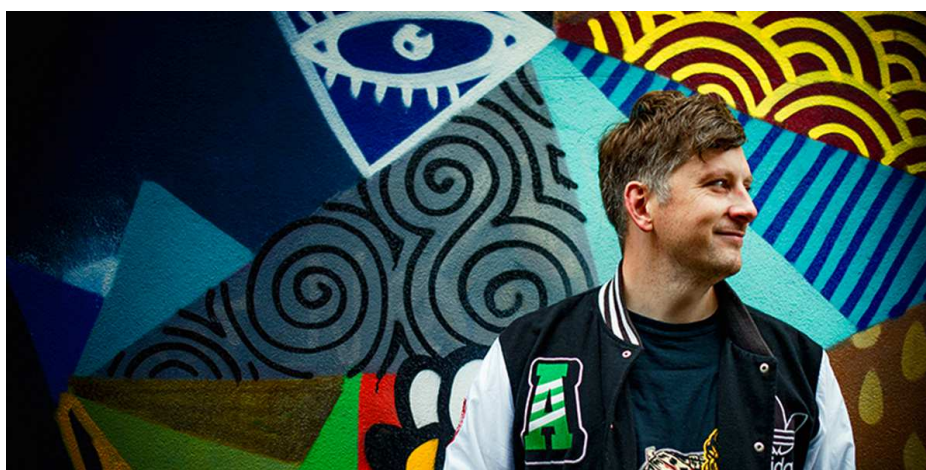

Shane O'Malley, Street Artist

Shane O'Malley, born 1985, from Navan now resides in Galway City. With paint as his medium, he works on large spray painted public murals. He is among a leading group of contemporary artists that have emerged from Ireland's vibrant graffiti subculture to work in the mediums of paint, murals and art installations.

He studied visual communication in Limerick School of Art and Design. There he developed a bold graphic style. Continuing to paint graffiti strengthened his vibrant colour use, he has painted walls in Ireland, the UK, Poland, Hungary and the Czech Republic. His work can be viewed around Ireland in public spaces and as part of private collections. He has also exhibited work in group exhibitions in Galway, Dublin, Cork and Limerick.



Concepts. So I split my time working on corporate jobs and my personal work. Jobs can range from Graphic art, Indoor and outdoor large murals as well as illustration.

My personal work focuses on issues close to my heart. My exhibitions have explored themes like mental health, the meaning of home and Identity and shine a light on the positive support networks of family, friends and faith.

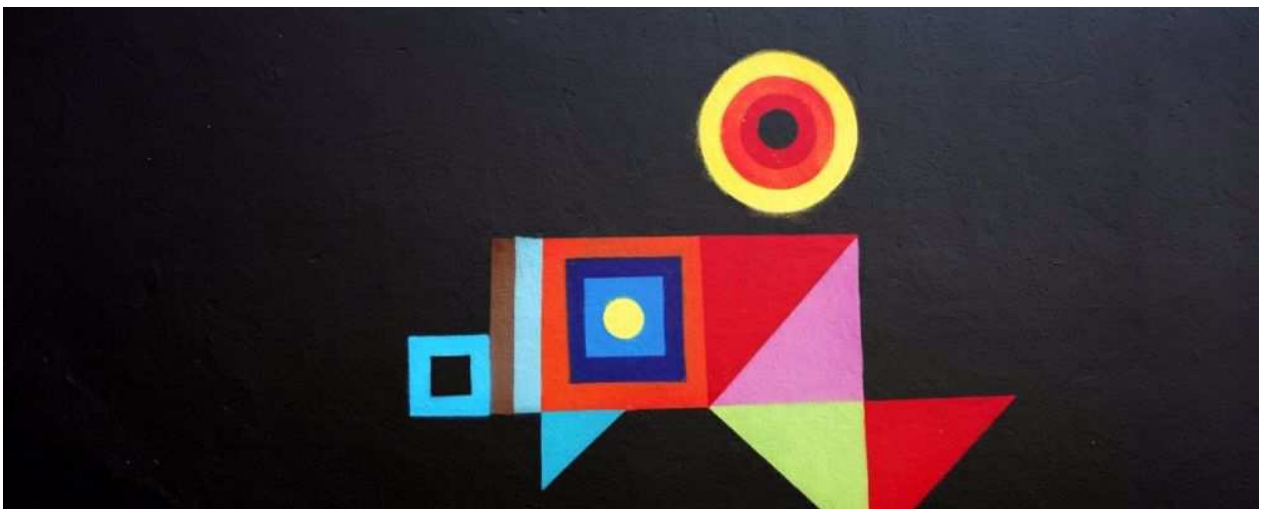

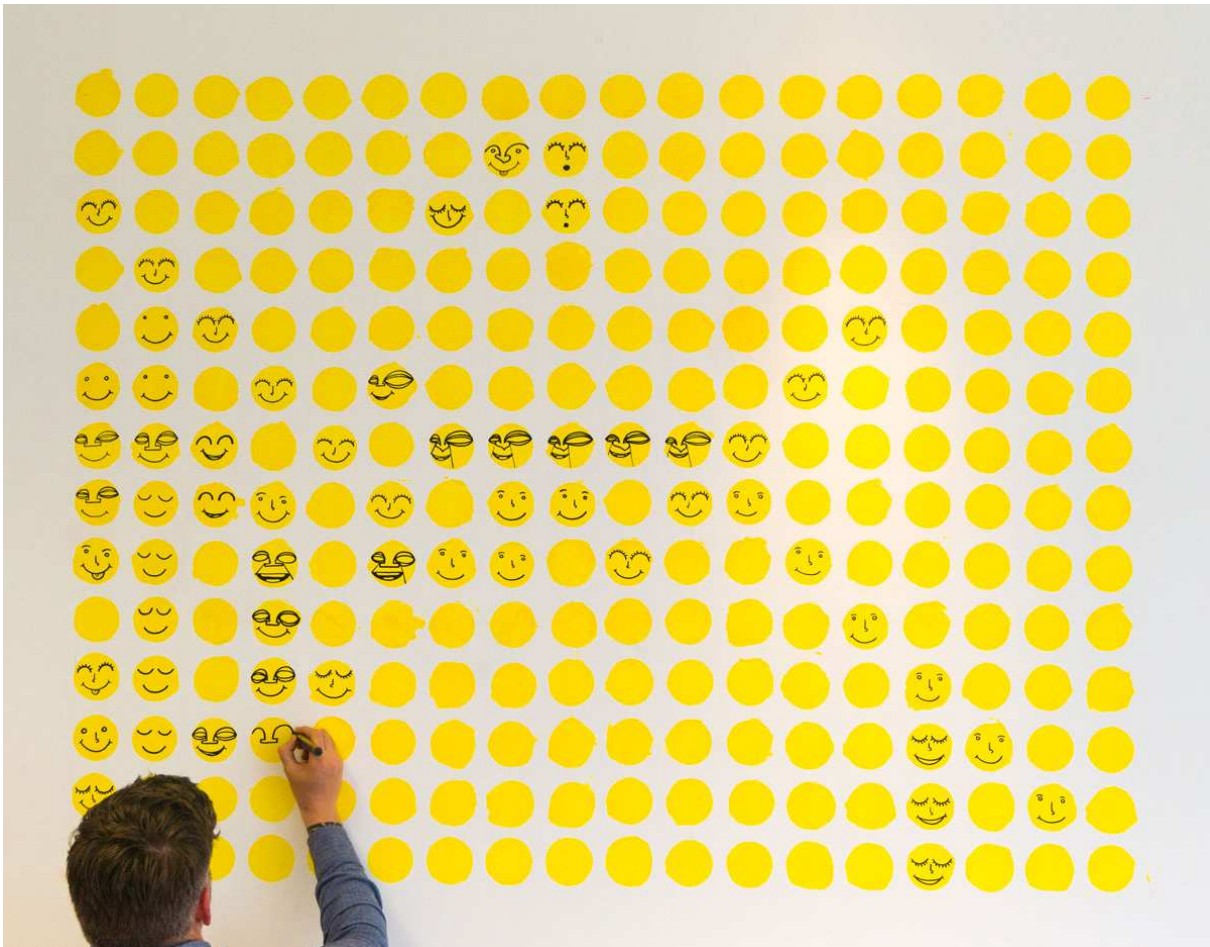
