The Clan gathered in Galway City Museum on Friday night and were entertained by a young local harpist while sipping wine, local craft beer and very tasty canapés.

Councillor Eileen Mannion, newly appointed Cathaoir-leach of Galway Co Council warmly welcomed the Clan to Galway. The first Rally in Galway since 1997, when Ann was Chieftain.

Renowned musician Gerry Hanbury entertained us with the history of Oró sé do Bheatha Bhaile, followed na a rousing rendition of what has become a Clan Anthem.

Special Guest, Gov Martin O'Malley captivated the audience with a potted history of his personal search for his Irish Roots. He wowed the clan with a moving song, Sweet Clonbur, telling the tale of this journey.

Dr Jackie Uí Chionna led a fascinating tour of Galway Waterways, this ended in Monroes Pub, a Galway institution where the evenings events were reviewed!

On Sunday, The Annual Clan Mass was a moving event held in the shelter of Claregalway Augustinian Abbey which dates from the 14th century.

The procession of Chieftains, led by Bagpiper Des, through the ancient Abbey, was very special. Interestingly Thus included 12 Chieftains, 6 men and 6 women.

Eamonn O Donoghue led a short but fascinating tour around the abbey before the Clan continued to Claregalway Castle.

The Clan invaded Claregalway Castle on Sunday for Féile Uí Mháille the OMalley Clan Family Day.

Dr Maurice Gleeson gave a humorous and fascinating talk on DNA, with a summary of his findings to date on the O Malley Clan. This was complemented by a presentation on Family Tree research by Dolores O'Shea.
